

Service Sheets and photos a lasting memory



Visual images play an important part of virtually every funeral that we arrange these days.

The service sheet or service book provide a tangible item for people to relate to the loved one whose life they are celebrating, while photographs provoke often quite amazing memories of the person and help us laugh (and cry) as we remember.

As well, the service sheet or book and photographs are something guests can take with them as a keepsake not just of the funeral, but of the person. These service books are highly valued as a symbolic representation of that person's life.

I am constantly amazed at how many service books are kept and then retrieved when people seek our advice on arranging another funeral.

High quality service sheets have traditionally been difficult (and expensive) to produce in the short timelines usually associated with a funeral.

To overcome this, Gippsland Funeral Services have invested in top quality colour laser printing systems with stapling, collating and folding options. This enables us to produce great quality service books at a reasonable cost for our families – all in a short turnaround time that is essential for funeral services. Multi page books, such as those used for a Catholic Mass or more detailed services, are easily accommodated.

Many have been produced with multiple pages of photographic tributes enabling all mourners to take home special images of the deceased.

Large Format Printing

Similarly we have invested in large format printing to create photographs that are a powerful symbol at a funeral.

Photographs often instantly connect those attending the funeral with memories of the deceased and shared experiences of time spent together.

Gippsland Funeral Services produce images up to A0 poster size (841mm x 1189 mm) on high quality gloss paper. We also have the necessary frames and stand to display many sizes of image including A0, A1 and A3.

All of our service levels, except the Essential Care Service, include a photograph of either A1 or A3 size. Families can upgrade to other sizes for a modest cost.

The photograph is returned to the family, allowing for permanent framing and display in the family home.

These photos are of great comfort to families and mourners when set up at the funeral, creating an atmosphere in which we can all celebrate a loved one's life.
